How would you express the “Nature of the Finger Lakes?” Create, share, sell your work at the Fort Hill Performing Arts Center Gallery

Deadline for submissions – Midnight, June 15

Email up to 3 JPEG images of your work to FHPACGallery@gmail.com with the subject RE : “Artist Showcase.” Your JPEG images must be attached individually to the email. Please attach rather than embed the picture in your email. File size: no larger than 2 megabytes.

The photos of the artwork you email should be cropped so matting and framing are not visible, and the work should be square and aligned so it isn’t distorted. The images may be used on our website. Artwork should relate to the theme, “Nature in the Finger Lakes.”

Label your images like this:	Examples:

Maximum & Minimum sizes of 2D art: a MAXIMUM of 30” in any direction, including diptychs, and a MINIMUM of 12” in any direction, including framing. MINIMUM of unframed artwork is also 12” in any direction. Freestanding floor sculpture can be taller than 30” but not wider.

When delivered, artwork needs to be ready for display. 2D artwork needs to be wired for hanging and matted and framed appropriately. Non-permanent medium should be under glass or plexiglass, such as watercolor, pastel, photo, drawing, ink. Metal or canvas photo prints are OK if wired for hanging. Wrapped canvas paintings can be unframed, but need to be neatly painted to the edges and wired for hanging. 3D work needs to be freestanding. (We only have a few sculpture stands.)

The OCAC Exhibit Committee reserves the right to reject any artwork that is NOT PROPERLY MATTED & FRAMED AND WIRED AT TIME OF DELIVERY and accompanied by SIGNED LOAN AGREEMENT, which will be sent when the artwork is accepted for the exhibit.

A 30% Commission will be retained on any sales of art during the length of this exhibit, and split evenly between Fort Hill and the Arts Council. Artists/Photographers exhibit at his or her own risk.
